his list of instructions provide direction on how to restore a QuickBooks™ Backup File onto a local computer so it may be used as a working file. The names inserted here are for the Activity File for this course where Bob's Big Bakery is being used as the example company.

1	Go to the File menu. Then select Open or Restore Company.
2	Select Restore a backup copy . Then select Next .
3	Choose Local Backup. Then select Next.
4	From the Look In drop-down, choose where the backup file is currently located on your computer.
5	Select the backup file. (The file name should appear as "BobsBigBakery.qbb".
6	Select Open . Then select Next .
7	From the Save in drop-down, choose the location where you want to save the restored working file.
8	In the File name field, make sure the new file name matches the backup file name of "BobsBigBakery" with a .qbw at the end.
9	Select Save .
10	Carefully read and respond to any messages that appear before restoration begins.
